Your modern name; your SCA name; your SCA membership number & expiration date; and your mailing address, including your zip code

Photocopy of your Driver's License or government issued picture ID showing your modern name and zip code. If the zip code shown on your ID is incorrect, or the government ID does not include a zip code, a copy of a current utility bill may be used to verify the zip code. Family members, or other persons residing at the same address may use the same bill for verification of their zip code.

Your order of preference for the announced slate of candidates. List your most preferred candidates first, followed by your second choice, etc.

You may provide any commentary on the suitability of each candidate in this section.

Commentary should include whatever information you feel might be of value to the Crown in making an informed decision.
